Applicants who are shortlisted for interview should certainly visit the school if at all possible.

The new appointee will work with the Board of Trustees to develop a new Job Description/Performance Agreement during early 2018.

The new principal will start on the first day of term 1, 2018.

The closing date for applications is 5pm, Monday, 9 October 2017. We look forward to receiving your application.

Two other dates to keep in mind: short listing will be in the period 24-27 October and people will be told the outcome of that meeting within 48 hours - interviews will be on the Saturday, 18 November 2017.

The location: The school and its community is only 5 km from Waiuku. Housing around the area is much more affordable than Auckland City. Barfoot & Thompson report on Waiuku [March 2017] has average house prices at \$590,500 or weekly rental of \$415.

**E-mail your application form, covering letter and your CV as one PDF file if possible saved as "Your name Pukeoware School" to Alan – that is, like "Mary Jones Pukeoware School". No hard copy is required. Email – do not use Doc Hub, Google Docs etc. If your CV is too large for emailing in one document then email it in two "halves".**

You do not need to include transcripts, certificates with this material. However, if you are selected for interview you will need to produce, on interview day, the following:

- Teacher Registration card. [Proof of identity as a registered teacher]
- Tertiary study transcripts. [Proof that you have the qualifications you claim.]
- Two photo identifications such as Drivers' licence, passport or RealMe.
